General Employment Permit


For most roles, requiring a formal qualification and paying over €30,000.

Critical Skills Employment Permit


For roles with skills shortages, like IT, healthcare, and engineering.

Intra-Company Transfer Permit

For employees of multinational companies transferring to the Irish branch.

1 Qualifications


Relevant degree or experience aligning with the job role.

3 Skills Match

Your skills must align with roles experiencing shortages.


Document Submission



Incorrect Information


Double-check all details.
